How to practise spelling your common exception words-

<p><u>Common Exception Word Hunt</u> Write the words on pieces of paper and ask your adult to hide these around your room. Get a fresh piece of paper and write down the words you find.</p>	<p><u>Word Unscramble</u> Write the word down on a piece of paper. Cut each of the letters up and mix them up. Unscramble the letters to spell the word. Can you write it down on a piece of paper?</p>	<p><u>Writing Race</u> Write your common exception words on some pieces of paper. Look at a word and then flip this over. Who can write the word the quickest? You or your adult?</p>
<p><u>Speed write-</u> Put a timer on for one minute. How many times can you write the common exception words your adult says before the timer is up? Can you beat your last score?</p>	<p><u>Loo, Cover, Write, Check-</u> Google ict games loo, cover, write, check. Click 'enter your own words' and ask an adult to type your keywords in the box. Look at the word on the lid. Drag the letters onto the shelf to spell the word. Flush the toilet when you have spelt the word and a new one will appear.</p>	<p><u>Common Exception Word Book</u> Practise writing the common exception words in your blue book!</p>
